RE: JOINING INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS SELECTED IN NON-DEGREE (CERTIFICATE AND DIPLOMA) HEALTH PROGRAMS FOR YEAR 2026/2027

Congratulations on your acceptance to join Ruaha Catholic University (RUCU)! We are happy to welcome you to our academic community. We hope your time at RUCU will be both enjoyable and successful, and we look forward to supporting you throughout your educational journey. Karibu Sana.

1. LOCATION

Ruaha Catholic University (RUCU) is located at the center of Iringa Municipality, adjacent to the NMB bank Mkwawa Branch, which is along the Iringa - Dodoma Road. For those coming through Iringa bus terminal (Igumbilo), RUCU is about 11KM in Iringa town. For those coming through Dodoma Road should drop at Kihesa bus stand.

2. DATE OF ARRIVAL AND REGISTRATION

You are required to report at RUCU from **19/10/2026** ready for registration starting on **20/10/2026**. Failure to do so will lead to your place being forfeited and be offered to another candidate.

3. REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTRATION

For registration, you must bring with you the following:

- a) Originals of Certificates of Secondary Education Examination (O'Level Result slip) or Diploma Certificate for applicants with equivalent applications.
- b) Original Birth Certificate
- c) White Gum Boot (except for Pharmaceutical Sciences students)
- d) White Lab Coat
- e) For girls/women pursuing Pharmacy, Medical Laboratory, Clinical Medicine and Environmental Health programmes bring with you two white solo gowns, the gown should have a shirt like top and collar with 3 white buttons on the front, length of the gown should be more than 15cm below the knees. Knee length gown and above knee length gown will not be accepted white sweater with no hood

All correspondence should be addressed to the Vice Chancellor

(kofia), white long socks and black shoes. For hairdressers, you must have only five lines or cut your hair short.



- f) For girls/women pursuing Nursing and Midwifery bring two pink non solo gowns with white collar which has one pink line on the front left side of the collar, gown must be 15cm below the knee. Knee length gown and above knee length gown will not be accepted. The gown should be loose, non-tight on any part of the body, two white sweaters with no hood (kofia), white long socks and black shoes. For hairdressers, you must have only five lines or cut your hair short.

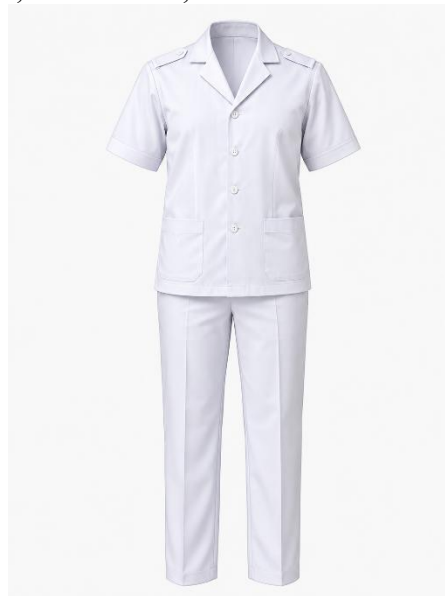


Note: For Muslims girls, white plain Hijab with no any kind of decorations is accepted.

- g) For boys/men pursuing Pharmacy, Medical Laboratory, Environmental Health and Clinical Medicine bring white short sleeve shirts and wafer (Khaki) trousers with black belt, white socks, black shoes.



- h) For boys/men pursuing Nursing and Midwifery bring two pairs of short sleeves white suits with one pink line on the left shoulder, the top of the suit should have white buttons, black belt, white socks, black shoes.



- i) For Clinical Medicine students must have the following equipment; Stethoscope, Manual Blood pressure machine, Mercury thermometer, Fetoscope, MUAC tape, Tape measure, Turning fork, Patella hammer, Pen torch, and Clerking board.
- j) For Nursing and midwifery students must have 8 equipment; Stethoscope, Manual Blood pressure machine, Mercury thermometer, Fetoscope, MUAC tape, Tape measure, Pen torch, and Clerking board.

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A. TUITION FEE PAYMENT

- i. The fee structures for all programmes are found on the RUCU website; www.rucu.ac.tz. Please visit the website for more information. Bring with you **evidence for payments made**, including Pay in Slips and texts. Note that, Cheques, cash, faxes, scanned pay in slips and emails of confirmation of payments **are not acceptable**.
- ii. Fees paid will not be refunded when a student withdraws or leaves the university without permission.
- iii. However, if a student receives prior permission from the Deputy Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs to withdraw from studies within the first two weeks of the academic year or semester, fifty percent of fees will be refunded.
- iv. Tuition fees are paid in four instalments. For further clarifications, **call 0712 601 060 OR 0736 500 292**

It is an offence to submit false information for admission consideration. Cases of impersonation and falsification of documents discovered either during registration or afterwards will lead to automatic cancellation of admission and will be reported to competent authorities for appropriate punitive action.

4. STUDENTS UNDER EMPLOYMENT

All students who are employed (in service) are advised to settle their release from duties from their respective employers before reporting to RUCU.

5. STUDY PERMIT

Foreign students are required to apply for Study Permits from their nearest Tanzanian Embassy before they depart for Tanzania.

6. HEALTH

Every student must be a member of the National Health Insurance Scheme or otherwise has to pay TZS. 50,400/= during registration to be a member of National Health Insurance Fund (NHIF)

7. RESIDENTIAL ACCOMMODATION

``First Pay, First Served``. Rooms are limited and will be issued from 18th September 2026. Students interested in staying at RUCU Hostels can pay the accommodation fee of **350,000/=** per year. Please call **0747454383** or **0712601060** for more clarification and for reservation.

8. TEACHING AND LEARNING FACILITIES

RUCU is one of the **best** Universities in Tanzania with very modern teaching and learning facilities such as digital library and computer labs. However, you are encouraged to come with

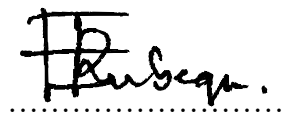
